Last 7 years we have rescued more than 6000+ stray dogs in madurai and surrounding city. Rescues will be done depend upon the shelter space in the last 3 months. we have rescued sick, injured and disabled stray dogs in street side.

Challenges we are facing in rescues?

Daily we get a 20 to 25 rescue calls in our surrounding of 15 cities. In rescue we love to save all the stray dogs But we are having only limited space and manpower. So we can't able to rescue all the stray dogs. These are the challenges we are facing now. To solve this problem now we have started the over the horizon project to extend the capacity of our shelter.

SHF MISSION RABIES FREE ZONE MADURAI



We started our rabies free zone program on 25th September before the "world rabies day". More than 500+ stray dogs gets vaccinated in 10 days with a help of stray dog feeders and our catchers team.

"Alertness, awareness and vaccination can help fight the disease."

According to scientific research the most effective rabies control strategy is through the vaccination of stray dogs in all rabies-risk areas. The Safe Home Foundation (SHF) non-profit organization | charity plans to conduct a mass rabies vaccination program in and around Madurai city and surrounding areas. In the first step, we already completed a comprehensive survey of the numbers of stray dogs in Madurai city and the surrounding areas. Based on the information from the survey, we started a mass rabies vaccination program, starting with the areas that are most at-risk of rabies transmission.

Our primary goal is to initially vaccinate at least 80% of the stray dogs within each area. We will then we consider such areas to essentially be a rabies free zone. This vaccination program will proceed across all areas in and around Madurai city and surrounding areas. Every year the mass vaccination program will be continued with the goal to eliminate rabies in Madurai city.

SHF SPAY/NEUTER



Sterilisation plays a crucial role in reducing the population of stray dogs in our city. With millions of stray dogs across 15 cities in our vicinity, the impact of our efforts is substantial. Over the past 7 years, we have successfully sterilised 6421 stray dogs.

Total number of stray dogs sterilised in July to September month- 162

Challenges we are facing in Sterilisation!

SHF operates on spay/neuter for stray dogs in our surrounding of 15 cities. 3 lakhs of stray dogs available in our surrounding of our 15 cities. But we are doing limited numbers of Sterilisation because of space in our current shelter. So we need to increase the number of sterilisation in upcoming days. But the exciting news is that we are on track to establish a new permanent shelter. Once operational, this shelter will enable us to sterilise 1000 stray dogs per month, leading to a significant positive change in our city and its surroundings.

Over the Horizon project!

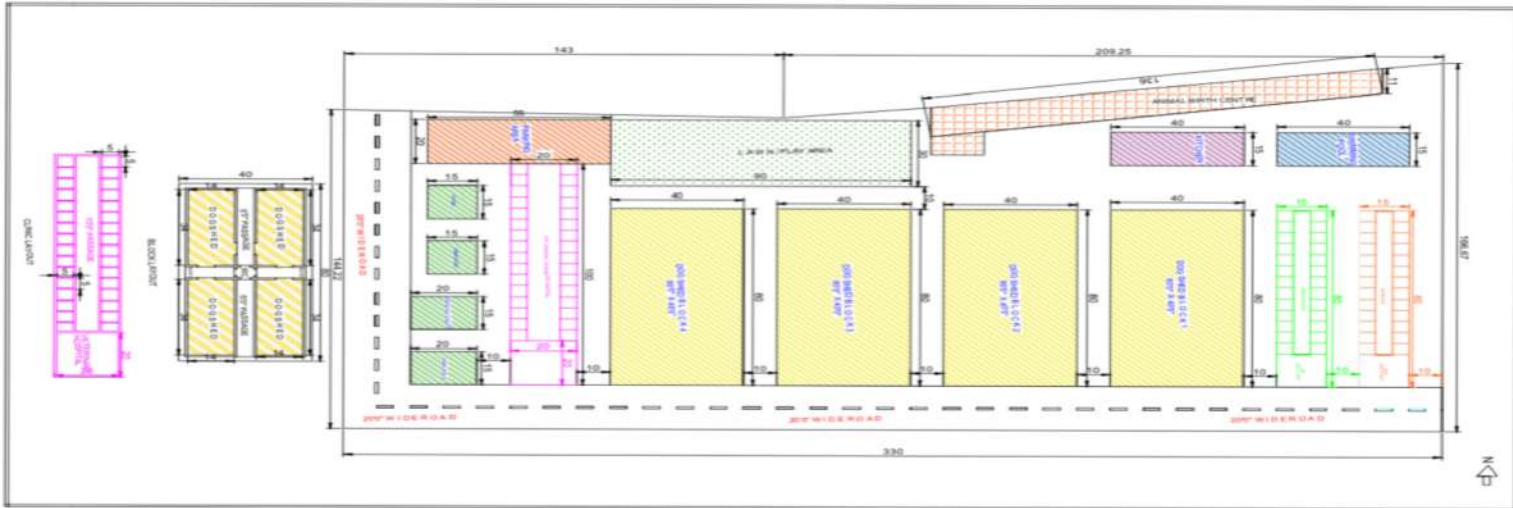
Everyone knows that our current shelter lease going to expire on March 31, 2025. we have started the over the horizon project on July month. SHF is pleased to announce that it has successfully completed Phase I of our Over The Horizon Project in record time, which was the acquisition of a suitable land plot for the expansion of the SHF facilities.

The land plot has been registered in Safe Home Foundation's name as a not-for-profit registered charitable organization (Registration

Number BK4/46/20) with accreditation from the Animal Welfare Board of India. Thanks to both private and corporate donations from within India as well as across the globe, SHF now owns it own land plot so it is no longer beholdng to a landowner and the typical concerns regarding lease expiry and annual rent increases. A big thank you to all donors who made Phase I possible!

Phase II

With Phase I complete, and with input from a professional architect, SHF has drawn up detailed plans for the design, development / construction of the infrastructure on the newly purchase property. Refer to Appendix 1. This phase of the project should be considered as a long-term goal and the construction of infrastructure will be carried out in an incremental manner, in alignment with the receipt of financial donations and receipt of other 'resource' related donations (e.g., donation of construction materials, manpower resources, etc.).

The priority for construction includes the building of two blocks (for the existing dogs in our care), a veterinary hospital with operation theatre and a kitchen (for preparation of food for both dogs and staff). Thereafter, as already mentioned, additional construction will be on an incremental basis and will allow us to expand significantly the number of dogs in the care of SHF.
